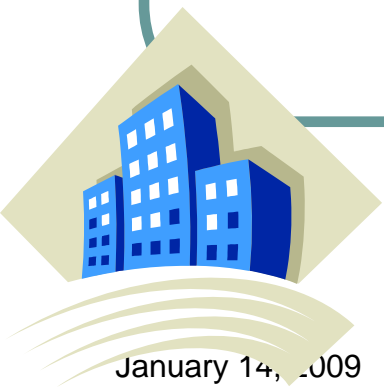

# Energy Efficiency Projects

- Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007, 12/19/2007
  - Three new Public Policy Goals
    - Reduce energy use 10%\*\*
    - Sustainable design
    - Renewable energy production\*\*
  - \* \* New \$4,000,000 maximum for certain 504 Projects – Energy Efficiency Projects

# Reduction of Energy Consumption

- Policy Goal up to \$4,000,000
  - What is the present energy consumption?
  - What is the projected energy consumption?
  - How were such projections made?
  - What is to cause the reduction?
  - Is the reduction 10%?

# Reduction of Energy Consumption

- Improved HVAC
- Improved insulation / lighting
- Superior design/efficiency in a new or improved location

# Sustainable Design

- Public Policy Goal, up to \$2,000,000
  - Sustainable Design is as defined by Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) standards.

- Policy Goal allowing up to \$4,000,000
  - Biomass
  - Hydropower

  - Ocean thermal – wave and tidal action
